

Junior Camps (3-4yo):

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Payment is regarded as acceptance of the booking conditions.
- 2. Children must be aged between 3 and 4 years of age to be eligible to attend our Junior camps.
- 3. Please note that only additional siblings from the same family can avail of the reduced rate. Furthermore, the reduced rate for siblings only applies if both children are attending the SAME camp. E.g. Both attend our Junior Camp. If one child attends our Senior Camp and the other attends our Junior Camp for example, they must both pay the 1st child rate (full price) for each camp.
- 4. All Parents/Guardians must sign our **Online Injury Waiver Form** prior to their child's attendance at our camps. This is mandatory. 1 signed form is sufficient to cover all camps attended in the calendar year. Failure to sign the form will result in your child being denied entry to the camp.
- 5. **Cancellations:** All cancellations are subject to forfeiture of a booking deposit per child (if full payment is made the balance of the fee will be refunded). Deposits are non-refundable and places are non-transferable.
- 6. Cancellations under 7 days prior to the first day of camp, are not entitled to any refund.
- 7. **Deposit Paid**: Remaining payment is required on the specified date made aware to you. Failure to comply might result in your child being omitted from the camp without a refund on your deposit. The specified date for paying the final balance will be made aware directly after you pay your deposit (it will be stated clearly on your booking confirmation, sent via email).
- 8. Due to child safety regulations, parents/guardians are NOT allowed to watch/participate in the running of the camp.
- 9. Camp starts at 9:30am and finishes at 1pm each day. The camp staff or The Underdog Games Ltd company is not responsible for children's safety and wellbeing outside of these times.
- 10. Any participant whose conduct is deemed by the Camp Manager to be detrimental to the best interest of the program (incl. the wellbeing of staff, other children and/or themselves) will be dismissed and no refund will be made. The parents/guardians of the child will be contacted by phone and the child will be removed from all activities until they are collected.
- 11. The Underdog Games Ltd reserves the right to refuse admission to any child at any time for any given reason.
- 12. Children must comply with all safety requests by their teachers. Failure to comply will result in the child being removed from the activity.
- 13. All allergies and/or medical conditions of the children attending the camp MUST be listed on the Application Form. Failure to accurately inform the camp of any pre-existing condition may result in the child's immediate dismissal and/or a ban from attending future camps.
- 14. We at The Underdog Games Ltd reserve the right to cancel a camp or change camp dates in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 15. The program will operate to the highest safety standards; we shall not be responsible for any illness, death or accident unless occasioned by the proven negligence on the part of the Camp Directors or their employees. Please note that active participation in physical activities carries a risk and understand that The Underdog Games Ltd operate the activities with health and safety key to the operation of these events. The Underdog Games Ltd have full public liability cover for all activities undertaken. Personal Accident Insurance against injury, accident, or loss whilst on camp is the responsibility of the client.
- 16. The camp accepts no responsibility for items lost/stolen or damaged on the premises. We recommend that children leave any valuables at home.
- 17. We do not return lost property so make sure when leaving that you bring everything with you.
- 18. We at The Underdog Games Ltd reserve the right to modify our program of activities in the event of unforeseen circumstances.
- 19. Phones: Any and all digital devices (with the exception of smart watches) are banned from use by children while attending our camps. If a child wishes to bring a device to camp they must switch it off and leave in their bag until after they leave the premises at the end of the day.
- 20. Photographs and video footage may be taken for promotional reasons. Children who do not wish to be photographed, must make this clear to staff prior to the first day of camp.
- 21. Places are allocated on a first come first served basis.
- 22. Permission is granted to seek medical treatment in the event of an accident.
